Background

Z/Yen have used analytics extensively with Membership Associations, to help them understand the trends that are affecting the Association and their members.

SAMI has run a series of workshops over the last 18 months on the future of Professional Associations. As a result we have understood many of the uncertainties facing Membership Associations, and the need to anticipate the future

as well as understand the lessons from the past (analytics).

SAMI Consulting has collaborated with Z/Yen on a number of projects on Long Finance – for instance the study on the future of Financial Services “In Safe Hands?”, which has been used globally to prompt discussion and new thinking. ACCA have used it as the basis for a global project on “Access to Finance for SMEs”. Our work on the future of membership associations framed the recent Institute of Directors Strategy AwayDay.

We have decided to combine our expertise to offer this interactive seminar on future-proofing the use of analytics for Membership Associations.
